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- 13. No order or Customer obligation may be cancelled, rescheduled, rescheduled or a saigned without Seller's prior written authorization and, in such event, Customer will be liable to Seller for any additional costs and expenses incurred by Seller. Prices are also subject to change in response to supplier price increases or if a price has been quoted in error, whereupon, Customer may cancel the undelivered portion of any affected order by delivering written notice to Seller prior to the shipment thereof and within 10 days of its receipt of notice of the price increase. Seller may assign its accounts receivable. In order to defray the cost of Customer account administration, any amount owed to Customer which remains unclaimed by Customer for a period of twelve months will become the property of Seller.

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
